Jacqueline Tarun Davis, of Grasonville, MD, died Saturday, September 18, 2010 at the Hospice Center. She was 75.

Born November 4, 1934 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of Louis F. and Mary Alice Beck-Tarun. She grew up in Baltimore. Jackie worked for Stewarts as a bookkeeper and she later worked for the Lumber Mill. On December 22, 1956 she married William Allen Davis, Sr. and they lived in Baltimore and she became a homemaker. In 1969 they moved to Grasonville, MD, where they raised their family. In 1974 she returned to work for Friel's as a bookkeeper and later for Westinghouse as a purchasing clerk. Jacqueline retired in 1998 from Northrop Grumman.

Jackie was very active with Kent Island United Methodist Church where she taught vacation bible school, Sunday School, and helped develop the Rainbows Program and was part of the Stephens Ministry. She participated as a Cub Scout Den Mother. Jackie loved to play bingo, collect lighthouses, make teddy bears, watch the Ravens, and spend time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren. She was a hockey mom and grandmom.

Jacqueline is survived by seven children, Richard B. Davis of Front Royal, VA, Toni D. Veasel of Queenstown, MD, Kimberly A. Tippet of Grasonville, MD, Darlene M. Harbaugh of Grasonville, MD, Bradley A. Davis of Millersville, MD,

Danny M. Davis of Floresville, TX and William A. Davis, Jr. of Floresville, TX; eighteen grandchildren and five great grandchildren. She is predeceased by her husband, William A. Davis, Sr.(1986) and two sons, Frederick W. Davis (1998) and Keith B. Davis (2010).
