



Jacquelyn Sue Dungan

December 11, 1954 - March 3, 2013

Jacquelyn S. Dungan, 58, lived her life with grace and beauty, conceding her bout with cancer in the same manner on March 3, 2013. A loving mother, daughter, wife, and friend, Jackie never missed opportunities to lend a skillful hand, a level head, and a friendly smile. That smile will be missed by many, but her legacy of kindness and compassion will remain.

Jackie was born in Minneapolis, MN, on December 11, 1954, as the treasured daughter of Marge and Stan Earl, and childhood adversary of her brother, Steve (Annie). She graduated from Southwest H.S. in 1972, and earned an A.A. degree from Normandale Community College in 1974. Jackie moved to Seattle in 1978, where she studied to begin her 26-year travel agent (CTC) career. She was a frequent international and domestic traveler, with a great appreciation for adventure and plush accommodations. Jackie met commercial fisherman Chris Dungan while playing pick-up soccer in Seattle, and they were married in a renowned Minneapolis celebration in 1983. The young family expanded with daughters Allison (1985) and Kelli (1987) in Washington and Oregon, before moving to Easton, MD in 1989.

In Easton, Jackie worked for many years managing local travel agencies, before making a transition to supervising the antics of Annie, Sweetzer, and the Lost Boys of Campbell's Jack's Point Boatyard in Oxford. Most recently, Jackie took great joy and satisfaction from her work as Birthday Party

Coordinator for the YMCA of the Chesapeake. A consistent supporter of her children's many activities; Jackie was a Brownie and a Girl Scout troop leader, a PTA officer at White Marsh Elementary and Easton Middle schools, and a regular field trip chaperone. She served as Team Mom or game announcer for numerous soccer, lacrosse, and track teams at Easton High School, as a Save Our Sports officer, and as an organizer of after-graduation parties. Jackie was a longstanding and well-rewarded mentor to Ariyana Bell and her brothers and sisters. In all of her professional and volunteer functions, 100% was Jackie's minimum effort, and perfect was good enough.

Jackie's faithful love of life and friends will be celebrated at 10 a.m. on Saturday, March 9 at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Lane, Easton, MD 21601, and subsequently in Minnesota.
