James Elmer "Pat" Patterson Allen, Jr., of Wye Mills, MD, passed away on October 23, 2016, at his home. He was 67.

Born on March 2, 1949, in Easton, MD, the son of the late James Elmer Patterson Allen, Sr. and Violet Gernert Allen, he grew up in Wye Mills, MD. Pat graduated from Queen Anne's County High School, Class of 67. He served in the US Coast Guard for four years stationed in South Port, NC, and Ocean City, MD.
