James F. Casey, IV, age 78, of Centreville, MD passed away on April 5, 2021 after a struggle with Alzheimer's.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Alice, son James Patrick (wife Jennifer), three grandsons James P. Jr., Timothy, Nicholas, three nephews (Alan, Glenn, Shawn, and a niece). He is also survived by brother Timothy and sister Joyce Svedberg.

"Jim" was an avid outdoor person working as a Marine Biologist for the State of Maryland for 40 years. He would instruct several students from Frostburg College in marine life in Ocean City and the impact of the environment on the Chesapeake Bay.

He became an assistant Scout Master for Centreville Troop 247. A group of fathers and Jim would take the troop camping and eventually canoeing in the Adirondacks, where the boys earned their 50 miler badge.

At this same time, Jim participated in the MD 1st regiment Unit which does reenactments concerning the Revolutionary War.

The "Old Wye Mill" came into his life because of the Mill's involvement in the Revolutionary War when Gen. George Washington commissioned flour and grain from the mill. Jim was a miller at the mill for over 35 years, even "dressing out" the grinding stones- his comment on this was "never again" – it was back breaking work, and his knees took at least a week to recover.

For a short time in the late 60's he worked as a photo interpreter for the Pentagon.

Jim led a very interesting and sometimes colorful life. He will be sorely missed by his family and friends.
