James Henry Cecil of Centreville, MD, died at his home on Thursday, March 28, 2013. He was 60.

Born September 23, 1952, in Sudlersville, MD, he was the son of the late, Marvin H. and Elizabeth Taylor Cecil. He was a graduate of Queen Anne's County High School. In 1976, he married the former Dianne Pullen, and they made their home in Centreville. He was an employee of the Queen Anne's County Roads as a construction supervisor for over 30 years when he retired. He then was contracted with the Roads Dept. for six months.

He enjoyed working and tinkering in the garage with engines, rabbit hunting with his beagles, fishing, and crabbing.
