James Edward Craig of Waynesboro, VA, died on Sunday, December 14, 2003, at the Chester River Hospital Center. He was 91.

Born on January 12, 1912, in Sugar Hollow in Albemarle County, VA, he was the fifth of fourteen children born to the late Jacob Franklin and Annie Moore Craig.

At a young age, Mr. Craig worked as a farmer and logger before moving to Williamsburg, VA, to work with his aunt in the Douglas Family bakery. There he met and married Eunice Poarch in April of 1931.

He worked in the re-construction of Colonial Williamsburg for several years prior to beginning a 23-year career as a carpenter with the U.S. Army at Ft. Eustis in Virginia.

In 1954 he purchased a farm outside of Williamsburg, VA, which he operated with his family. In 1966, he sold the family's farm and later owned and operated other farms in western Virginia.

In 1972, he purchased a small farm in Waynesboro, VA, and continued to live there for the next 29 years. He spent his time there growing fruit trees and vegetables, things he enjoyed doing immensely.

Mr. Craig was a devoted family man who loved the outdoors.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Jack Talton Craig of Kent Island, MD, and Michael Edward Craig of Huntsville, TX; a daughter, Colleen Craig Lamb of Katy, TX; a brother, Guy M. Craig of Waynesboro, VA; a sister, Mary Ring of Virginia Beach, VA; nine grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Services will be held on Friday, December 19, 2003, at 10:00AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD.

Interment will be held in Waynesboro, VA.
