



James Ronald Crouch Sr.

March 19, 1936 - March 12, 2013

James R. "Jimmy" Crouch, Sr., died on Tuesday, March 12, 2013, at Genesis Health Care-The Pines in Easton, MD. He was 76.

He was born on March 19, 1936, in Chester, MD, to the late J. Walter Crouch and Katherine Kersey Crouch.

Mr. Crouch attended Stevensville High School, graduating Class of 1955. He began working on the water until 1958 when he enlisted in the U.S. Army. After serving 19 months in Germany, he was honorably discharged in 1960.

Upon returning home, he married Anna P. Ihle on September 10, 1961, and they resided in Grasonville. In 1964, he and his wife moved to Easton, where he began his career with Coca Cola as a driver. He retired from Coca Cola in 1995, and began working for Murdoch's Florist in Easton. While working at Murdoch's as their delivery man, his wife became ill, and he took a leave of absence. Anna Crouch predeceased her husband on June 14, 2003, after 42 years of marriage. He later returned to Murdoch's as their handyman. He is a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church.

Mr. Crouch is survived by two children, Tina Baynard and her husband, Scott, and James R. Crouch, Jr., and wife, Belinda; four grandchildren, Nick Baynard, Paul Crouch, Kate Crouch, and Samantha Crouch; one sister,

Nancy Bly; and two brothers, Billy Crouch and Gordon Crouch. Jimmy and his wife were also very close with Christine Crouch, their grandchildren, Paul and Kate's, mother.

In addition to his wife and parents, he was preceded in death by four siblings, Jean Crouch, Jackie Crouch, Mary Anne Trapp. and Ruth Thompson.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, March 18, 2013, at 11 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where family and friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park.

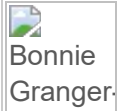
