James N. "Puggy" Culley of Rock Hall, MD died on Tuesday, December 10, 2002 at Magnolia Hall Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 82.

Born on December 3, 1920 on East Neck Island Rock Hall, MD, he was the son of the late James N. Culley and Marva Etta Goodman Culley Freeman. Mr. Culley worked his entire lifetime as a waterman in Rock Hall, MD. He served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII in the Asiatic/Pacific Theatre and was honorably discharged. He returned to Rock Hall, MD where he operated his boat "Go Girl" until November of this year. He was the oldest working waterman in Rock Hall.

He was a member of Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion Post #228 in Rock Hall, MD. He enjoyed bowling, shooting, playing pool and cards, and dancing.

Mr. Culley is survived by his wife whom he married on November 24, 1948, Annie May Jordan Culley of Rock Hall, MD; a son, James Nelson Culley, Jr. of Rock Hall, MD; a daughter, Edith Ann Culley Elbourn of Chestertown, MD; grandchildren, James Jordan Elbourn and Nicole Elizabeth Elbourn, both of Chestertown, MD, and Samantha Joanne Elbourn Seago now stationed in Chicago, IL and one great grandson, Donald Willard Seago III also Chicago, IL.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 13, 2002 at 2:00 P.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Rock Hall, MD where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service (1:00-2:00pm). Interment will be in Wesley Chapel Cemetery.
