James R. "Jim" Davis of Chestertown, Maryland died on May 18, 2007 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 95.

Born in Delmar, Delaware on February 6, 1912, he was the son of the late, John James and Effie Lee Adkins Davis. Mr. Davis began work at an early age on the family's farm. On June 20, 1931 he married Geneva Katherine Funds and they lived in Laurel, Delaware where he worked as a truck driver, delivering vegetables up and down the east coast during the depression. He and his wife moved to Chester, Pennsylvania where they resided for thirty years. Mr. Davis worked as an electrician with Eddystone Printwork, Sunship Building, and Globe Union (now Johnson and Johnson Controls) from which he retired in 1974. He and his wife moved to Middletown, Delaware then Tolchester, Maryland.

He was a member of the Tolchester Community Association, St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Rock Hall Senior Citizens, and was a past member of the St. Andrews Society. He enjoyed fishing and gardening.

He was predeceased by his wife of 64 years, Geneva on February 25, 1996 and a son, George R. Davis in 2002.

Mr. Davis is survived by two daughters, H. Joanne Maiero of Wyomissing,

Pennsylvania and Elaine K. Pierdomenico of Wilmington, Delaware; 8 grandchildren; 18 great grandchildren, and 4 great great grandchildren.
