James Earl Davis, formerly of Trappe, MD, a retired carpenter, died at Cadia Rehabilitation Renaissance, in Millsboro, DE, on Friday, October 5. He was 92.

Born at Tunis Mills, Easton, on June 27, 1920, he was the son of the late Thomas Herman and Minnie Felgenhauer Davis. After attending public school, he worked on the farm until the age of 14 when he began working with his father in the carpentry business. During his career as a carpenter, he worked for J. Russell Summers Inc., Seymour Builders, Rumsey Seymour Inc., and Lyons Builders until retiring in 1982. He then drove a school bus in Talbot County for 10 years.

A member of the Loyal Order of Moose #534 in Harrington, DE, he was also a life member and past chief and past chief engineer of the Trappe Volunteer Fire Company.

His first wife, the former Laura Saulsbury whom he married in 1943, died in 1993. Mr. Davis is survived by his present wife, Virginia Davis, whom he married in 2003; several stepchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
