James (Pop/Jimmy/Jim) Henry Elburn Sr. (90) of Sudlersville, Md, passed Sunday July 19, 2026. He was born June 15th, 1936, in Chestertown, MD to the late William Elburn and Jesse Brooks Elburn.

James was a graduate of the Sudlersville High School. After graduation he joined the Army in October of 1956. During his military service, he was a SP4 in the Signal Core and later joined the Fire Dept. Section called Hunter Liggett Military Reservation. After discharge in October 1959, he returned to Chestertown MD where he delivered flowers for Elburn Florist. Later he was employed by Baltimore Business forms as a printer. He also worked for Queen Anne's County Public Schools as an overnight janitor at Queen Anne's County High School.
