September 20, 1963 - March 11, 2012

James Cree “Jace” Eliason of Charlotte Hall, MD, died on Saturday, March 10, 2012. He was 48.

Mr. Eliason was born on September 20, 1963, in Chestertown, MD. He was the son of Walker Cree Eliason of Chestertown, MD, and the late Elizabeth Ann Smith Eliason. He graduated from Mercersburg Academy in June 1982 in Mercersburg, PA, and from St. Mary’s college in 1987 with a Bachelor's of Science degree in Human Services. He married Merry Moore, and they were married for 13 years. He re-married to Robbie Robinson on August 17, 2007.

Jace worked as a Computer Programmer with Automated Graphic’s Systems for the past 24 years in White Plains, MD. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints in White Plains, MD. Jace was also a Webelo Leader for Pack 921 Boy Scouts of America; he enjoyed gardening, skiing, spending time with his daughter, and the outdoors.

In addition to his wife, Roberta Jeanne Eliason and his father, Jace is survived by his daughter, Aimee Eliason of Baltimore, MD; three stepsons, Kevin Robinson, Michael Carinci, Patrick Carinci all of Oneida, NY; a half-brother; Pete Rayfield of GA; three half-sisters, Linda Carbo of GA, Gini Wiley of FL, and Suzanne Crossan of GA; and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins.
