James Lawrence Ford was born on September 5, 1922. He was the son of Nicholas Ford and Johanna Ford (Dickman). He grew up on his father's dairy farm in Cockeysville, MD. His family owned a NR Ford, a Watchmen's Service, at the Harbor in Baltimore City for generations.

After farming for a while in Taneytown, MD, James and his Uncle bought a farm on Thompson Creek Road in Stevensville, MD. He lived there with his parents, until retiring and selling the farm to the Hurst Brothers, of the Lord Baltimore Laundry, and continued as the caretaker of the farm, which the Hurst family used as a Hunting Preserve.

James and his mother built a house on Greenwood Creek in Queenstown, MD. James favorite pastimes were hunting, raising a hunting dog, sailing and trap shooting. He was a State Champion at one point and shared this love with his grandson, Robert Jason Blunt, for a while. He continued shooting into his early 90's.

James was predeceased by his parents. He is survived by his wife of 25 years, Ruth Tarr Blunt Ford, his stepson Robert William Blunt, stepdaughter, Diana C. Blunt, grandchildren; Angela, Robert J. and Eric A. Blunt, and his great grandson, Grayson Lawrence Testerman. James is also survived by step nieces and nephews, including two Godsons, James Aaron Wildt and Patrick James Wildt of Towson, MD.

James passed quietly at his home in Centreville. He is laid to rest at Woodlawn Memorial Gardens.
