



James C. Frampton

March 26, 1930 - December 19, 2012

James Caulk Frampton, died Wednesday, December 19, 2012, at his home. He was 82. Mr. Frampton was born in Easton on March 26, 1930, son of the late Bennett S. and Martha Findley Frampton.

Mr. Frampton was a 1947 graduate of Easton High School. He served in the US Army during the Korean conflict and helped with building the Libby Bridge and prisoner exchange compound at Panmunjom. Mr. Frampton worked for C. Albert Matthews, Inc., for 50 years, specializing in the construction and restoration of many schools, armories, court houses, college dorms and historic buildings.

He was a member of Trappe United Methodist Church, American Legion Post #70, a Past Master of Coats Masonic Lodge #102, and director and former VP of Eastern Shore Threshermen. He was a former member of Trappe Volunteer Fire Department and three antique car clubs, Bay Country Region AACA, Chesapeake Bay Model T, and Nations Capital Model T.

Jim loved to build things. He built the house he lived in for 56 years, garages, lawn chairs, sideboards, a $\frac{3}{4}$ scale model of a 1901 Olds, two steam engines and two trailers to haul them. He also restored a 1923 Model T Roadster and a 1927 Model TT truck and several antique tractors.

Mr. Frampton is survived by his wife of 61 years, Margaret (Peggy) Frampton; his two children, Edward Frampton of Ocean City and Mary McCarty (Ron) of Easton; two grandchildren, Melissa Higginbottom (Dr. Erik) and Sarah McCarty; one great-grandson, Grant Higginbottom; a brother, Francis Frampton (Marjorie) of Lewes, DE; and many beloved nieces, nephews, and in-laws.

A celebration of his life will be held on Saturday, January 19, 2013, at 11 a.m. at Trappe United Methodist Church, 29421 Maple Avenue, Trappe, MD 21673, with a Masonic service at 10:50 a.m. Inurnment will be at the convenience of the family.
