James Franklin Greenwood of Still Pond, MD died Saturday, October 31, 2009 at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 93.

As a young man he worked on local farms and delivered ice, he then worked as a welder for the Philadelphia shipyard before beginning his career at Aberdeen Proving Ground. Mr. Greenwood retired from Aberdeen Proving Ground in 1973.
