James Phillip Horney, Sr., “Capt. Phil” of Chester, MD, died Monday June 21, 2016, at UMSMC at Easton. He was 82.

Born on August 13, 1933, in Grasonville, MD, he was the son of the late Charles and Kit Horney. Phil grew up in Grasonville and attended Stevensville High School. He served in the U.S Army from 1953 to 1955 and returned to the Eastern Shore to marry his beloved wife Jacqueline Wyatt on November 27, 1955.

Capt. Phil was a successful waterman. He crabbed in the Eastern Bay and hand-tonged for oysters throughout the Bay. He made his own eel pots and fished them in the Wye River. He loved working on the water and spending time with his family. He retired at the age of 74.

He is survived by his wife, Jacqueline Wyatt Horney of Chester, his sons; James Phillip Horney, Jr., and wife, Joyce and Charles “Chet” Horney both of Chester; his daughter, Eve Fishell and husband Kevin of Federalsburg, MD; seven grandchildren, Brian and Kevin Horney, Jonah Saunders, Joy Crossley, Kit, Cassidy, and Karley Fishell; nine great-grandchildren; and three of his seven siblings, Paige Demma, Mike Horney, and Dave Horney.

He is predeceased by his brothers, Joe and Wayne Horney, and sisters,

Norma Benney and Peggy Donovan.

A memorial prayer service will be held at 11AM on Thursday, June 30, 2016, at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD.

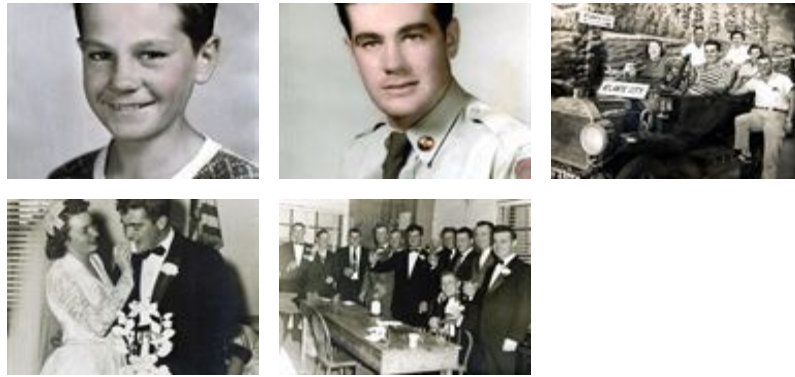
