James "Jim" Franklin Covey died on Wednesday, December 12, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD. He was 85.

Jim was born on March 18, 1933, in Easton, MD, to the late Arthur Franklin Covey and Naomi Blanch Jones Covey. He graduated from Easton High School, Class of 1951.

Jim proudly served in the U.S. Army and was a Retired Sargent from the Maryland State Police after 25 years of service. He was a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and St. Mark's United Methodist Church. After retiring, Jim enjoyed playing golf. He also took over his fathers' business of breeding horses for racing. Jim and Pat enjoyed going to Florida in the winters and camping.

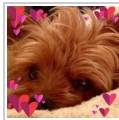

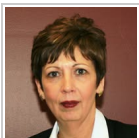
