James Milford "Jim" Todd, Jr. of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, October 5, 2011, at Christiana Hospital in Newark, DE. He was 85 years old.

Mr. Todd was born on February 7, 1926, in Cambridge, MD. He was the son of the late James Milford Todd, Sr., and Naomi K. Mills Todd.
