



James A. McCauley

March 23, 1919 - July 19, 2013

James Andrew “Jim” McCauley of Chestertown, MD, died on July 19, 2013, at Harford Memorial Hospital. He was 94.

He was born in Elkton, MD, on March 23, 1919, the son of the late James Jacob and Amanda Hedricks McCauley. He graduated from Chestertown High School and served in the U.S. Army during his service he landed on the beaches of Normandy on D-Day as squad leader, was awarded the Purple Heart, and was honorably discharged in 1945. He returned to marry Jane Bennett on April 29, 1945.

Mr. McCauley graduated from Bulova School of Watchmaking in New York. He worked for 38 years with Colonial Jewelers in Chestertown as manager, watchmaker, and jeweler.

He was very involved with the Chestertown Lions Club and had served as President, Deputy Governor, and was on the regional district cabinet board for over 20 years. He was also very active with Christ United Methodist Church and Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown. He was an avid gardner, loving husband, great father, and dedicated citizen.

In addition to his wife of 68 years he is survived by his daughter: Ruth McCauley Brown of Chestertown, Md. He is predeceased by a son the late

James Richard McCauley (1971) and a brother the late Henry McCauley (2012).

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, July 24, 2013, at 2 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road in Chestertown where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service (1:00-2:00). Interment will be in St. Paul's Cemetery.
