



James W. Mitchell Sr.

June 14, 1920 - October 2, 2012

James Walter Mitchell, Sr., of Cordova, MD, died at his home on October 2, 2012. He was 92.

Born in Easton on June 14, 1920, he was the son of the late Charles Walter and Mary Elizabeth Stewart Mitchell. After graduating from Easton High School in 1939, he worked as a dairy farmer and had lived at Bluff Point Farm, near Cordova since 1953. He had also been an owner operator of a school bus for the Talbot County Board of Education since 1951 and a star route mail carrier since 1973.

A member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church where he was a past elder and a past congregational president, he was also a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622 and Talbot County Farm League and the Easton Pony League and founder and past president of the SOS Club at Easton High School.

Mr. Mitchell is survived by his wife, the former Dorothy Marie Asche, whom he married in May 1941; three sons, James W. Mitchell, Jr., and Terry E. Mitchell, both of Cordova, MD, and Timothy A. Mitchell of Taylors Island; a brother, Thomas E. Mitchell (Charlotte) of Easton; nine grandchildren; and ten great-grandchildren.

Mr. Mitchell was predeceased by a son in 2005, Steven D. Mitchell; and a

brother, C. Stewart Mitchell.

Funeral services will be held at the Immanuel Lutheran Church, 7215 Ocean Gateway in Easton on Saturday, October 6, 2012, at 11 a.m. Friends may call Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, on Friday, October 5, from 6-8 p.m.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery in Easton.

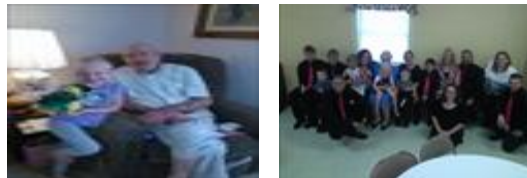
