James D. Morris of Cordova died on Sunday, October 4, 2009 at Mercy Hospital in Baltimore, MD. He was 84.

Born July 12, 1925 in Cordova, he was the son of the late, William and Annie Swartz Morris. After attending public school in Talbot County he, in 1947, married the former Brena Marie Eaton, who died on November 21, 2006. Since 1950, he had worked for C. Albert Matthews, Inc. until his retirement.

He was a life member of the Cordova Volunteer Fire Company and a life member of the VFW Post #7937 in Greensboro. He was also a World War II Army veteran, serving in Shanghi, China.

Mr. Morris is survived by four children, James D. Morris, Jr. of Cordova, Stanley E. Morris, Sr. of Preston, Brenda Marie Chance of Easton, and Charles A. Morris of Cordova, a sister, Florence Simmons of Chestertown, and a brother, William H. Morris of Easton. He is also survived by nine grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren. In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by a daughter, Sherry Ellen Morris, who died in 1986, two sisters, Ruth Morris and Elsie Sheets, a brother, Albert R.
