James Clark Palmatary, 20, of Easton, MD, died on Friday, November 4, 2011. Born in Easton on March 28, 1991, he was the son of James Elwood Palmatary, Jr., and Lisa Bennington Palmatary of Easton.

James participated in the NJROTC program for four years at Easton High School, graduating in 2010. Immediately upon graduation, he entered the United States Army and served as Ranger until being honorably discharged in June of 2011. James served as a volunteer for Waterfowl Festival for nine years. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed fishing, hunting, and crabbing with his friends and family. He was his Dad's "sidekick" and loved to make people laugh.

In addition to his parents, James is survived by a sister, Amanda Palmatary of Easton; a half-brother, Jimmy Barringer of WV; grandparents, Phil and Ethel Smith of Ridgley, Ann Gerhardt of St. Michaels, and Larry and Marty Bennington of Centreville; an aunt, Janice Enfield and her husband Ken of Easton; an uncle, Steve Palmatary and his wife, Stephanie and their daughter, Natalie of Queen Anne; great-grandparents, Sheldon and Dorothy Lee Windsor of Cambridge, and Dorothy Miles of Denton. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, James E. Palmatary, Sr., and his grandmother, Jenny Palmatary; and an aunt, Debbie Ann Palmatary Cole.

A celebration of life for James will be held on Friday, November 18, 2011, at 11 a.m. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peach Blossom Road, in Easton, where friends and family may call one hour prior to the service. Interment will be private at a later date.

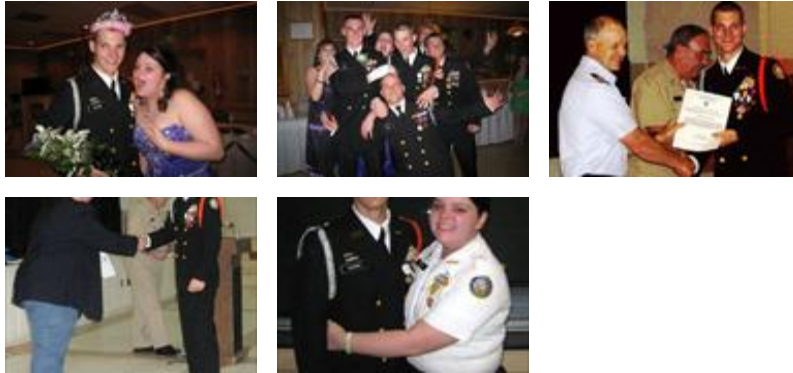

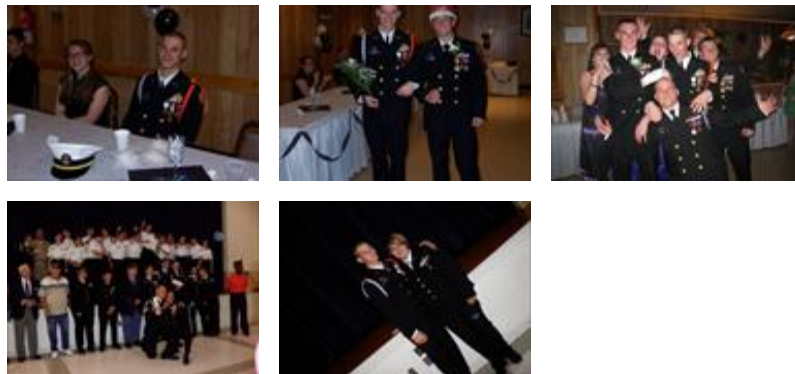
