James Andrew Riedy of Elkton, Maryland, died Tuesday, June 14, 2005, at his residence. He was 50.

Born June 9, 1955, in Wilmington, Delaware, he was the son of the late, A. Noble Riedy and Helen Brice Riedy of Newark, Delaware, formerly of Chestertown, Maryland. As a child, Mr. Riedy spent his summers in Chestertown with his grandparents, the late, Peter and Helen Brice of Arcadia Farm in Langford.
