



James Elliott Schweppe Sr.

January 24, 1929 - April 9, 2021

James Elliott Schweppe, Sr., passed away on April 9, 2021, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. He was 92 years old.

He was born in Wilksburg, PA, on January 24, 1929, the youngest son of the late Lindsay E. Schweppe and Emma Jane Elliott Schweppe. Jim grew up in Verona, near Pittsburgh.

He graduated from Clarion University in Pennsylvania, Class of 1951 with a Bachelor's degree.

Following college graduation, Jim served honorably in the United States Army during the Korean War.

On June 23, 1954, James married Patricia Ann Skinner of Corry, PA. Jim was employed as a systems analyst in finance for Pittsburgh Plate & Glass, a systems manager at Johnson & Johnson Devro Division, and later as a financial systems consultant.

Jim previously lived in Flemington, NJ, for over thirty years and then resided in Dover, DE, for ten years before moving to Easton, MD, in June of 2020 with his son, Jim Jr. and daughter-in-law, Robin.

He was a member of the Wyoming United Methodist Church in Delaware and

formerly a member and ordained Elder of the Flemington Presbyterian Church in New Jersey.

Jim is survived by his sons; James (Jim) E. Schweppe, Jr. and wife Robin of Easton, and Scott C. Schweppe and wife Susan of New Haven, VT; and grandchildren, Jennifer, Lauren and Sarah.

In addition to his parents, Jim was preceded in death by his wife, Patricia, who died December 23, 2020, and his brother, Robert L. Schweppe and his wife, Miriam.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, May 14, 2021, at 10 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., in Easton.

Interment will be held later that day at 2 PM at the Veteran's Memorial Cemetery in Millsboro, DE.
