



James Scott Starkey

April 14, 1929 - April 2, 2008

James Scott Starkey of Centreville, MD, died at Memorial Hospital in Easton on Wednesday, April 2, 2008. He was 78.

He was born April 14, 1929, in Baltimore, MD. He was the son of the late Dr. Edgar Bennett and Edith Anderson Starkey. He was a graduate of Church Hill High School Class of 1946. He served in the US Navy as an Aviation Electronics Technician on the aircraft carrier U.S.S. Midway (CVB-41) and was honorably discharged in July of 1952.

He retired from the U.S. Post Office after serving 35 years as a clerk in the Centreville Post Office and as a rural letter carrier in Sudlersville and Queenstown. He was a coach for little league baseball, a charter member of the Centreville Jaycees, and served on the Town Zoning Board for several years.

His love for the Bible and his devoted faith were shown as Jimmy was an active member of the Centreville United Methodist Church, having served on many church boards and committees. He also taught adult Sunday School for over 30 years.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara Binebrink Starkey; three grandsons, Richard Starkey and his wife Nicole, Andy Starkey and wife Kristen, and Scott

Starkey, all of Centreville; and two great-grandchildren, Cole and Lejla Starkey. He was preceded in death by his son, Kevin Scott Starkey, and his brother, Elmer B. Starkey.

Services will be held at 11:00 AM on Monday, April 7, 2008, at the Centreville United Methodist Church. A visitation will be held on Sunday, April 6, 2008, from 6:00-8:00 pm at the church.
