James Bartlett Starkey, 91, of Easton, MD, passed away on Wednesday, December 24, 2014, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center in Easton. Mr. Starkey was born in Church Hill, MD on June 2, 1923. He was the son of the late Lloyd Watts Starkey and Marie Anthony Starkey.

Mr. Starkey graduated from Centreville High School in 1940. He served in the United States Army during World War II, where he met and married the former Anneliese Fandrich in 1949 in Fuerth, West Germany. He was employed at the VFW, E. E. Streets Memorial Post # 5118 for over 25 years, where he received a life membership. He was later employed by Waverly Press, retiring as a supervisor. He enjoyed gardening and playing golf with his wife, who died on May 10, 1992.

He is survived by two daughters, Helga S. Remington and her husband, Don of Easton, and Karen M. Starkey of Easton; a granddaughter, Stephanie L. Saunders and her husband, Rick of Easton; a grandson, Anthony Remington and his wife Cindy of CA; and two great-grandchildren, Carter and Trent Saunders.
