James Clifton Thomas, affectionately known as Jimmy, was born in Church Hill, MD on September 13, 1915. He was the son of the late Fred and Rachel Bordley Thomas. He departed this life on Sunday, October 10, 2004 at the Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD, at the age of 89.

During his early years, Jimmy attended school in Queen Anne's County. He later served in the U.S. Army during WWII and received the American Service Medal (a WWII Victory Medal). He was honorably discharged in March of 1946. Jimmy worked in construction in PA and NJ. He later worked for Rent-A-Wreck in Dover, DE until his health failed.

Jimmy was a member of Mt. Pleasant U.M. Church, Pondtown, MD, where he served as a trustee. He was a member of the Queen Anne's County Senior Center at Crumpton, MD. Jimmy enjoyed fishing, traveling, ball games and talking about the "old days."
