James L. Zinnel of Chestertown, MD died on Sunday, January 27, 2002 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown, MD. He was 73.

Born July 31, 1928 in Worthington, Minnesota, he was the son of the late Carl H. and Lucille Olson Zinnel.

Mr. Zinnel served in the U.S. Navy from 1946 until 1948 when he was honorably discharged.
