James Alfred "Abby" Andrew of Easton died at his home on Sunday, December 22, 2002. He was 85.

Born in Easton on February 19, 1917, he was the son of the late Addison and Georgia Frampton Andrew. A graduate of Easton High School in 1934, he spent the majority of his working career as a sales person, most recently with The Country Shop at Hillsboro, MD.

A lifelong resident of Talbot County, he, for many years, officiated at high school sports and volunteered with the Little League and the Pony League. He loved fishing, hunting ducks and geese, his beagle and labrador dogs, birdwatching and the Baltimore Orioles.

Mr. Andrew was graced with a wonderful smile, gentle disposition, was very gracious and appreciative of life's little things, deep friendships and was a man of simple means.

His marriage to the former Dorothy E. MacEwen on March 25, 1939 ended in divorce. On April 5, 1968, he married the former Mary K. Dolby who died January 29, 1988.

Mr. Andrew is survived by two daughters, Anne E. Lyons of Bethany Beach,

DE and Dorothy A. Cain of Easton; a son, Robert P. Andrew of St. Michaels; two sisters, Julia A. Crowding and Edith A. Harrison, both of Easton; nine grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and one great-great-granddaughter. Another son, John Addison Andrew died September 25, 1992 and a sister, Frances Wilkinson, died March 3, 1988.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, December 30, 2002 at 11:00 AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
