James A. Daniels of Pondtown, Millington, Maryland died on Saturday, May 12th at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown, Md. He was 91 years of age.

A life long resident of Pondtown, Mr. Daniels was the son of the late John & Ella [Caulk] Daniels. He was educated in the Queen Annes School system. In his younger years he worked on an area farm, Dixons Furniture, Inc., and the Pennsylvania Railroad. He retired in the mid 1960's.
