James Douglas Rorer of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, February 11, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 82.

Born July 5, 1921 in Lynchburg, VA he was the son of the late David Parker and Elizabeth Johnson Rorer. During World War II he served in the United States Coast Guard. Following his release from active duty, he worked for thirty-five years for the Atomic Energy Commission and the Energy Research and Development Administration. He lived in Montgomery County, MD most of his life until moving to Talbot County in 1978.

A member of the Royal Oak Community United Methodist Church where he served as treasurer and in various other capacities, he was also a member of the Edge Creek Boat Club, volunteered as a Boy Scout leader, an AARP tax preparer and served as a board member of the Chesapeake Center, Inc. He was a member of Easton Elks Lodge #1622, Isaak Walton League, Navy League, American Legion Post #70, University of Maryland Terrapin Club, and a longtime volunteer for the Memorial Hospital at Easton Auxiliary and many other charitable organizations.

Mr. Rorer was preceded in death by his wife of fifty-four years, the former Carol Martin, who died February 28, 1996. He is survived by two sons, James D. Rorer, Jr. of Henderson, Nevada and Dale M. Rorer of Ft. Meyer, FL; his

loving companion Nancy Obitz of Oxford, MD; three sisters, Helen Hahn, Mary Worley and Nancy Jennings; and two brothers, William Rorer and Benjamin Rorer all of Virginia; five grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. He was predeceased by a brother, David Rorer.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, February 14, 2004 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call on Friday evening from 6 to 8 PM and one hour prior to the service.

A graveside service will be held on Monday, February 16, 2004 at 1:00 PM at Spring Hill Cemetery, Lynchburg, VA.
