James E. Garrett died peacefully at his home in Oxford, MD on Sunday, March 9, 2003. He was 80.

Born January 24, 1923 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Norman W. and Ethel Edwards Garrett. During World War II he served his country as a Navy pilot. In 1949 he graduated from the University of New Mexico in Albuquerque and then worked for several years in Chihuahua, Mexico. In 1980, after retiring from a career in Chemical Engineering at DuPont in Gibbstown, NJ, Old Hickory, TN, Wilmington, DE and Youngstown, NY, he and his wife Doris moved to Oxford, MD. They traveled extensively and were avid sailors before and after retirement.

Mr. Garrett is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Doris Hume; four sons, James Garrett, Jr. of Pegram, TN, Stephen Garrett of Boothwyn, PA, Douglas Garrett of Wilmington, DE and William Garrett of Bluemont, VA; and two grandchildren, Peter and Alison.

A private memorial service will be held at a later date.
