



James Ewing Stayton

James “Bucky” Stayton of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, February 23, 2005 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 73.

Born in Easton on June 2, 1931, he was the son of the late George W. and Lydia Georgia Richardson Stayton. After graduating from Easton High School in 1948, he worked for Elliott Equipment. In 1952 he entered the U.S. Army where he served in Korea during the Korean Conflict. Wounded in action, he received the Purple Heart Medal, the Korean Service Medal, the UN Service Medal and the National Defense Service Medal. After his release from active duty, he returned to Elliott Equipment for a short time, and then worked as a general contractor with George W. Stayton & Son until his retirement in 1993.

A lifelong resident of Easton, he was a member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W. where he served as Chaplain and Captain of the color-guard. He also served as Chaplain with American Legion Post 70, was a member of the Purple Heart Association and the Disabled American Veterans. A charter member of St. Mark’s United Methodist Church, he served as usher, member of the administrative board, President of his Sunday School Class and past President of the Yater Bible Class. In his spare time he loved bowling and fishing.

Mr. Stayton is survived by his wife, the former Joyce C. Goslin, whom he

married in Easton on June 18, 1952; two children, Doug G. Stayton of Easton and Denise S. Johnson of Salisbury; a sister, Audrey S. Woolston of Easton; and four grandchildren, Matthew James Stayton, William Cody Stayton, Nicholas Johnson and Benjamin Johnson.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, February 26, 2005 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD, where friends may call on Friday evening from 7 to 9 PM.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.
