James Francis Hall, Jr. of Church Hill, MD died at the Hospice Center, Centreville, MD on Monday, October 4, 2010. He was 94.

Born August 19, 1916 in Church Hill, MD, he was the son of the late James Francis Hall, Sr. and Mary Walls Hall. He attended Church Hill High School. On December 31, 1942 he married Eloise Cole of Bridgetown, MD. They were married 67 years and she pre-deceased him on January 28, 2009. Mr. Hall farmed the family farm with a dairy herd until recent years.

He was an avid hunter, most especially fox hunting and was one of the first in the area to have a pond put in to enjoy watching and hunting the waterfowl.

He was a member of the Church Hill United Methodist Church and a lifetime member of the Church Hill Volunteer Fire Company, Queen Anne's County Farm Bureau and Ducks Unlimited. He and his wife were named Farm Family of 1991 where they received the recognition during the Queen Anne County 4-H Fair. He had a passion for gardening in his later years.

Mr. Hall is survived by three sons, James F. Hall, III and his wife, Lynda of Church Hill, MD, Larry Hall and his wife, Erin of Atlanta, GA and Robert Hall and his wife, Becky of Church Hill, MD; six grandchildren, Kevin Hall, Jamie Hall, Kelly Mantis, April Barzewski, Ashley Brockington and Morgan Hall and

three great grandchildren.

In addition to his wife, he was pre-deceased by three sisters, Elizabeth Green, Martha Williams and Anna Ross.
