



James Franklin (Frank) Kimble

March 4, 1933 - January 31, 2009

James Franklin (Frank) Kimble of Centreville, MD died Saturday January 31, 2009 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 75.

Born in Church Hill, MD on March 4, 1933, he was the son of the late James Webster Kimble Sr. and Georgianna Minch Kimble. He attended school in Church Hill. On May 16, 1953 he married Margaret Alice Spray of Worton, MD. He served in the United States Army for two years. Frank worked as a farmer in Kent County and later became a farm manager for Lynch Farm Enterprises in Queen Anne's County. In 1985 he established H&K Farms Inc and continued farming until his death.

Frank was an avid quail and waterfowl hunter as well as a sporting clay enthusiast and spent many happy hours with his close friends at J&P Sporting Clays. He encouraged and mentored many young shooters and farmers and was always ready to lend a helping hand to friends and neighbors. Frank was a Queen Anne's County Weed Control Board member, and also a member of Ducks Unlimited and the National Sporting Clay Association. He was also active in his church Our Mothers of Sorrows and St. Peter's Catholic Church.

Frank, a loving husband and father is survived by his wife Margaret Kimble of Centreville; one son Albie Kimble and wife Joanne of Church Hill, MD; four daughters, Lydia Johnson and husband Jeffrey of Chestertown, MD, Sharon
