James Herman Morris of Centreville, MD died suddenly at his home on Wednesday, March 12, 2003. He was 59.

Born August 30, 1943 in Centreville, he was the son of Hazel Hammond Morris of Easton and the late Herman Redman Morris. He graduated from Centreville High School in 1961. He later served in the U.S. Army as a Green Beret. Following his release from active duty he returned to Centreville where he operated the BP Gas Station in Centreville until 1973.
