James Warner Jacquette of Rock Hall, MD died Friday, April 1, 2011 at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 85.

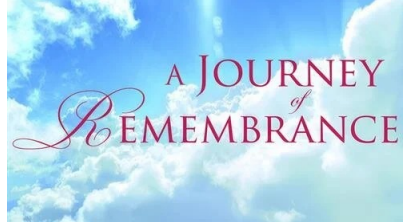
