



## James Lee Ewing

James Lee Ewing of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, December 22, 2004 at Corsica Hills-Genesis Eldercare, Centreville. He was 71.

Born in Talbot County, September 11, 1933, he was the son of the late Milton Greenley and Dorothy Anna Dulin Ewing. After attending public school, he worked as a floor sander until serving in the U.S. Army from 1935-1955. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Talbot County where he worked briefly as a floor sander until beginning his career as an electrician. He was employed by the Forney's Engineering Service in Easton for 26 years and then formed his own business, Ewing's Electrical Service, in which he remained active until its close in 1995 due to his failing health.

A lifelong resident of Talbot County, he was a member and former trustee of the Loyal Order of the Moose, Easton Lodge #1520.

Mr. Ewing is survived by his sister, Anna Jones, and a brother, Joseph Ewing, both of Easton. He was predeceased by two brothers and three sisters, Milton G. Ewing, Jr., Robert B. Ewing, Maria Lankford, Barbara Carmine and Dorothy Jones.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, December 29, 2004 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD, where

friends may call on Tuesday evening from 6 to 8 PM.

Burial will be at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
