James Marion "Jimmy" Bryan Jr. of McDaniel died unexpectedly Friday, June 19, 2003 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 56 years of age.

Born Jan. 19, 1947 in Easton, he was the son of the late James Marion Bryan and Peggy Cummings Bryan Granger. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1965, he completed a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agronomy from Delaware Valley College. With his years of hands-on experience and a proudly earned four-year degree, he returned to the family farm to pursue his love of farming. Later, Jimmy joined brothers Allen and Bill Bryan in the excavation business now known as Bryan and Sons.
