Stevensville, MD: James Matthais Mullen died Friday, October 13, 2006 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 90 years old.

Mr. Mullen was born on February 25, 1916 in Glasgow, Scotland, the son of the late John and Sarah Mullen. He moved to Baltimore, MD when he was nine years old and attended St. Gregory's Catholic School and Polytech High School. Mr. Mullen started working in the food distributing industry. On March 24, 1941 he entered the U.S. Army and was involved in the invasion of Normandy on "D" day. He received the European Theatre Ribbon, three bronze stars and the Combat Infantry Badge. He married Elsie Mary Parsons of Baltimore, MD on June 6, 1942. After separation from the Army, Mr. Mullen returned to work in Food distribution industry working for Morton Frozen Food and the 23 years with Kluge, Finkelstein Food Distributors. In 1977, his family moved to Stevensville, MD. He retired in 1981.

Mr. Mullen was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church, Kent Island American Legion, Knights of Columbus, Grasonville V.F.W and Kent Island Yacht Club.

Mr. Mullen is survived by his two daughters, Patricia A. Mullen and Elsie M. Mullen, both of Stevensville, MD. He was preceded in death by his loving wife, Elsie Mary Mullen; three brothers, John M. Mullen, Stephen B. Mullen and

Francis C. Mullen.

Funeral services will be held at St. Christopher's Catholic Church, Chester, MD on Tuesday, October 17, 2006 at 11 am. A visitation will take place on Monday, October 16, 2006 at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Chester, MD at 3-5 pm and 7-9pm. Interment will follow funeral service in St. Peter's Catholic Cemetery.
