James Milton Faulkner of Easton died at the Caroline Nursing & Rehab in Denton on Friday, July 7, 2006. He was 89.

Born in Caroline County, he was the son of the late Edgar T. and Ella Starkey Faulkner. After attending school in Talbot County he, in 1939 married the former Dorothy Melvin and they made their home in Queen Anne's County until 1945 when they moved to Talbot County, where he farmed in the Cordova and Matthewstown area. He was an avid gardener who raised vegetables and loved to give to family and friends.
