



## James Orval Jones

J. Orval Jones, a lifetime resident of Wittman, MD, died on Friday, November 17, 2006 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 87.

Born May 6, 1919 in Wittman he was the son of the late James Walter and Leona Haddaway Jones.

After attending public school in Talbot County he worked as a boat builder in association with his father in the business known as J. Walter Jones & Son. In the early forty's he served in the U.S. Army in the Philippines, Manila, and Bataan in the Army Medical Corp. Following his honorable discharge he returned to work with his father, he also worked as a waterman and then worked at the Memorial Hospital in the Plant Operations Department until his retirement in the 1980's.

He was a member of Asbury United Methodist Church where he served on the Board of Trustees, Sunday School Superintendent, and a member of the choir. He was a member of American Legion Post # 70 in Easton, a charter member of the WWII memorial in Washington D.C., and active in Boy Scouts of America.

His wife, the former Ella J. Marshall whom he married December 30, 1941 died May 6, 2001.

Mr. Jones is survived by his son Gary Jones and his wife Ruth Ann of Easton; two grandchildren Erin Jones and Brian Jones; and three great grandchildren, Tenley, Austin, and Holly.

He was pre-deceased by one sister Elma Miller, one brother Edwin "Webby" Jones, and two infant brothers.

Funeral Services will be held at Asbury United Methodist Church, Wittman on Wednesday, November 22 at 11:00 AM.

Burial will be held at Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Beulah.
