James R. Butler Sr. of Greensboro, formerly of Stevensville died at his home on Thursday, January 1, 2004. He was 80.

Born in Trappe, MD on November 15, 1923 he was the son of the late Floyd S. Sr. and Edith Chaplain Butler. After attending public schools in Talbot County, he worked as a farmer, then served with the U.S. Army in the South Pacific during WWII. Following his release from active duty he returned to the Eastern Shore where he resumed farming and later worked for the Annapolis Block Company which became Gomoljak Block for more than 20 years.

He was a member of the American Legion Post 273, Stevensville, MD.

In addition to his wife of 60 years, the former Julia Cole whom he married on September 21, 1943, Mr. Butler is survived by six children; James R. Butler Jr. of Apple Valley, CA; F. Sheldon Butler of Harrington, DE; Julia B. Barry of Denton, MD; Sallie B. Leager of Church Hill, MD; Michael C. Butler of Denton, MD; Brandon C. Butler of Ridgely, MD; two brothers, Raymond B. Butler of Harmony and Floyd S. Butler Jr. of Chester; one sister, Jennie LaFever of Shady Side; twelve grandchildren and sixteen great – grandchildren. Two brothers, John E. Butler, Robert L. Butler, one sister, Alice B. Collier and a grandson, Allen Butler are deceased.
