James Robert "Jimmy" Howden of Easton, MD died on Thursday, June 16, 2005 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 81.

Born December 16, 1923 in Lasswade Midlothian Scotland, he was the son of the late James Brydon and Isabella Pentland Porteous Howden. He was educated in Scotland and from 1940 to 1946 served in the British Merchant Marines. In April of 1949 he married Mary Lowther. They made their home in Scotland until moving to Easton, MD in 1965, where he was employed as a carpenter for Harry Heinsohn & Sons. Mrs. Howden died November 4, 1986.

A founding member of the St. Andrews Society, he was an avid photographer and loved to go to the beach at Ocean City and Rehoboth.

Mr. Howden is survived by his son, Robert Howden and his wife Lynne of St. Michaels; a sister, Barbara Howden of Earlston Berwickshire, Scotland; a brother, Ian Howden of Edinburgh, Scotland; and two grandchildren, Robert Jack Howden and Lyndy Suzanne Howden.
