



## James Ross Swann

J. Ross Swann of Trappe, MD died on Thursday, November 8, 2001 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 82.

Born April 22, 1919 in Greensboro, MD he was the son of the late Ralph and Iva Ross Swann. After graduating from Chestertown High School he served in the United States Army, in the South West Pacific, during World War II. Following his release from active duty he on May 11, 1946 married the former Esther Elisabeth Ellingsen and they lived in the Eastern Shore towns of Chestertown, Queenstown and Easton, before settling in Trappe in the 1960's. He worked for the C&P Telephone Company for 36 ½ years until his retirement in 1982. During his retirement, he volunteered many hours at Trappe United Methodist Church, where he was a member of the choir. He also enjoyed collecting antique tools. He was also a member of Telephone Pioneers of America and a past member of Trappe Lions Club and E.E. Streets Memorial Post # 5118 V.F.W.

Mrs. Swann died November 3, 1999.

Mr. Swann is survived by a son, Robert Swann and his wife, Sally of Baltimore, MD; a daughter, Lisa E. Swann and her husband, Christopher Cram of Washington, D.C.; one brother, Randall Swann of Wilmington, DE; two sisters, Beatrice Fenton of Bradenton, FL and Phyllis Matthews of Vierra,

FL and three grandsons.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, November 12, 2001 at Trappe United Methodist Church, Trappe, MD at noon.

Private interment will take place at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
