James Todd Horney, of Easton, a retired accountant, died Sunday, January 16, 2011 in Norfolk, Virginia.

He was born July 4, 1923 to the late, James Clifford and Hilda Augusta Todd Horney. After attending Easton High School, Mr. Horney graduated from Beacom Business College in 1942. Mr. Horney served in the U.S. Navy in World War II aboard the USS Alaska in the Pacific Theater and was honorably discharged as a Chief Petty Officer in 1946. The Alaska supported carriers making strikes on Tokyo, Iwo Jima and Okinawa. In March of 1946 Mr. Horney married the former, Blanche Bryan Willis of Centerville, Maryland.

Mr. Horney retired from his accounting business in 1985. An avid golfer all of his life, he formed the first Easton High School Golf Team in 1939. During the many years of playing golf he won numerous tournaments in the DelMarVa area and made lifelong friendships. He was a former member of the Talbot County Club and the Elks, Lodge #1622 in Easton.

Mrs. Blanche W. Horney, his wife of 60 years, died in 2006.

He is survived by his daughter, Linda L.H. Lewis and her husband, Errol, of Norfolk, Virginia and his son, John "Kip" Horney and his wife, Geri, of Monarch Beach, California. He is also survived by his beloved grandchildren, Dr. Bryan

He lived a long and full life. Mr. Horney was most proud to have served his country and to be a lifelong Eastern Shoreman.
