



James W. "Buddy" Rash

January 25, 1917 - November 17, 2009

James W. "Buddy" Rash died on Tuesday, November 17, 2009. He was 92 years old.

Mr. Rash was born on January 25, 1917 in Ridgley, MD. He graduated from Cordova High School in 1936. On March 17, 1942, he married the former, Anna Mae Gannon. After his service in the U.S. Army during World War II, he spent the majority of his career working for the McMahon Oil Company, until retiring in 1982. Following his retirement, he worked with his son in a lawn care business known as Rash Lawn Care.

Mr. Rash was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, American Legion Post #70, and the Cordova Alumni Association.

Mr. Rash is survived by a daughter, Dolores V. Sard (Ashley) of Trappe; a son, James H. Rash (Lee Ann) of Easton; four grandchildren; eight great-grand children, and a special care giver and dear friend, Tammie Sutphin, of Ridgley. In addition to his wife, Anna, Mr. Rash was predeceased by one brother and two sisters.

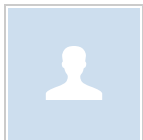
