Jana Hruska Fagan of Royal Oak died on April 17, 2001 after a six year battle with ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease). She was 62.

Born on December 3, 1938 in Omaha, Nebraska, she was the daughter of the late U.S. Senator, Roman L. Hruska, Sr., and the late Victoria Hruska. After graduating from high school in Washington D.C., she attended Hood College in Frederick, MD for two years. She then transferred to the University of Nebraska in Lincoln where she received a B.A. in Political Science in 1959. She was an Executive Assistant at the Republican National Committee, a Deputy Scheduler at the Congressional Campaign Committee, and the Washington Manager for the Whitaker & Baxter Public Relations firm. In 1968, she joined the White House staff as Executive Secretary to the Assistant to the President for Domestic Affairs.

In 1977, she named Assistant to the President of the American Enterprise Institute followed by a position as Assistant to the President of the Pharmaceutical Manufacturers Association. In 1985, she became the Director of Administration for the Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation where she remained until 1987 when she moved to Maryland's Eastern Shore.

In addition to her husband, Charles Fagan, she is survived by two brothers, Roman Hruska, Jr. and Quentin Hruska, both of Northern California; and three step-children, Beth of St. Louis, MO, Kathleen of San Marcos, CA, and James of Westin, CT.

A memorial service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein, & Newnam Funeral Home, Easton on Thursday, April 26, 2001 at 2:00 PM. Burial will be private.
