Jane Anne Kerns, 49, of Easton, MD, died July 6, 2006, at her home. Born in Philadelphia, PA, Janie grew up on a small farm outside of Sudlersville, MD. While attending Washington College, she taught English as a second language to migrant workers. After graduation, Jane moved to Royal Oak where she taught French at Saints Peter and Paul School in Easton.

Initially, Jane obtained a Master's Degree from the University of Maryland in language; she spoke French, Spanish and Portuguese. As her interests changed, she focused on victims' rights. Jane was instrumental in starting the Victims and Witness Program in Talbot County, and she also worked in Annapolis as a victim's rights advocate. Jane's second advanced degree was as a Clinical Social Worker, and for a period of time, she was employed at Easton Hospital, was in private practice, and later worked as a bereavement counselor.

From a small child, Janie loved animals and all living creatures. She was involved with the Humane Society and later organized a bird rescue program known as "Of A Feather." In recent years Jane's great love has been the exotic birds which she rescued and raised.

Jane was an agent of change and a social activist. Her life was a testimony of care and concern for those who lacked a voice. She fought to make a

difference, and she will be greatly missed by her family and friends. May God bless and care for her.

Jane is survived by her parents, Earl and Connie Johnson of Sudlersville; two sisters, Mary McGinnis and her husband Bob of Chestertown, MD, and Millie Strong and her husband Tot and family of Rock Hall, MD; and one brother, Timothy Johnson of Millington, MD.
