



Jane A. Wolfe

August 7, 1921 - April 2, 2009

Jane Asmussen Wolfe of Chestertown, MD, died on April 2, 2009, at Chester River Hospital Center. She was 87.

Born on August 7, 1921, she was the daughter of the late Henry and Ethel Lee Asmussen. Mrs. Wolfe was a Girl Scout leader; a public school teacher during the war years; a volunteer in the Well Baby Clinic in Prince George's County, Baltimore and Kent Counties; as well as at the Mental Health Center in Chestertown. She was also Treasurer and President of the Kent County Mental Health Association. For her working in starting the Good Neighbor Fund, Mrs. Wolfe was Maryland's Most Beautiful Person for Kent County in 1998. She was a Deacon, Charter Member, and Founding Member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown.

Her beloved husband, Melville Leaf Wolfe, predeceased her in 2008.

She is survived by a daughter, Lanetta "Lanny" Parks of Chestertown, MD; a son, James Melville Wolfe of Smyrna, DE; five grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren; two sisters, Betsy Wood of Tampa, FL, and Dee Cropper of Salisbury, MD; as well as several nieces and nephews.

A Memorial Service will be held on Thursday April 18, 2009, at 2:00 PM, at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown. Interment will be private. In lieu of
